KEEP YOUR CONSCIENCE CLEAR. THEN IF PEOPLE SPEAK AGAINST YOU, THEY WILL BE ASHAMED WHEN THEY SEE WHAT A GOOD LIFE YOU LIVE BECAUSE YOU BELONG TO CHRIST."

FAITHFULNESS

IS A **BIG** WORD THAT MEANS PUTTING INTO
ACTION WHAT WE BELIEVE AND HOPE FOR.

IT TAKES **FAITHFULNESS** TO
HEAR SOMEONE SHARE THE
GOOD NEWS—SO PAY ATTENTION!

IT TAKES **FAITHFULNESS** TO
BELIEVE IN YOUR HEART WHAT
YOU HEAR ABOUT JESUS.

IT TAKES **FAITHFULNESS** TO
REPENT OF YOUR OLD SINFUL
WAYS AND LIVE TO PLEASE GOD.

IT TAKES **FAITHFULNESS**
TO **DECLARE** THAT JESUS
IS LORD OF YOUR LIFE.

IT TAKES **FAITHFULNESS**
TO WALK INTO THE WATER AND
BE BAPTIZED.

ALL OF THESE THINGS ARE
JUST THE BEGINNING OF A
LIFE OF **FAITHFULNESS**
TO JESUS.

HAVE YOU HEARD THE GOOD NEWS?

1 WE ARE ALL SINNERS, AND DESERVE TO DIE IN HELL.

- ROMANS 3:23 SAYS, "FOR EVERYONE HAS SINNED; WE ALL FALL SHORT OF GOD'S GLORIOUS STANDARD."
- ROMANS 6:23 SAYS, "FOR THE WAGES OF SIN IS DEATH, BUT THE FREE GIFT OF GOD IS ETERNAL LIFE THROUGH CHRIST JESUS OUR LORD."



2 GOD LOVES YOU SO MUCH THAT HE SENT HIS SON TO DIE FOR YOUR SINS, SO THAT YOU WOULD NOT HAVE TO GO TO HELL.

- JOHN 3:16 SAYS, "FOR THIS IS HOW GOD LOVED THE WORLD: HE GAVE HIS ONE AND ONLY SON, SO THAT EVERYONE WHO BELIEVES IN HIM WILL NOT PERISH BUT HAVE ETERNAL LIFE."
- ROMANS 5:8 SAYS, "BUT GOD SHOWED HIS GREAT LOVE FOR US BY SENDING CHRIST TO DIE FOR US WHILE WE WERE STILL SINNERS. AND SINCE WE HAVE BEEN MADE RIGHT IN GOD'S SIGHT BY THE BLOOD OF CHRIST, HE WILL CERTAINLY SAVE US FROM GOD'S CONDEMNATION."



3 GOD RAISED HIS SON BACK TO LIFE, SO THAT WE WOULD HAVE HOPE IN A NEW, ETERNAL LIFE.

- 1 CORINTHIANS 15:3-4 SAYS, "I PASSED ON TO YOU WHAT WAS MOST IMPORTANT AND WHAT HAD ALSO BEEN PASSED ON TO ME. CHRIST DIED FOR OUR SINS, JUST AS THE SCRIPTURES SAID. HE WAS BURIED, AND HE WAS RAISED FROM THE DEAD ON THE THIRD DAY, JUST AS THE SCRIPTURES SAID."
- ROMANS 8:11 SAYS, "THE SPIRIT OF GOD, WHO RAISED JESUS FROM THE DEAD, LIVES IN YOU. AND JUST AS GOD RAISED CHRIST JESUS FROM THE DEAD, HE WILL GIVE LIFE TO YOUR MORTAL BODIES BY THIS SAME SPIRIT LIVING WITHIN YOU."

THANK YOU FOR TAKING A LEAP OF FAITH BY BEING RECEPTIVE TO THE GOOD NEWS. THAT'S THE FIRST STEP!



ROMANS 10:13-14, 17 SAYS, "FOR 'EVERYONE WHO CALLS ON THE NAME OF THE LORD WILL BE SAVED.' BUT HOW CAN THEY CALL ON HIM TO SAVE THEM UNLESS THEY BELIEVE IN HIM? AND HOW CAN THEY BELIEVE IN HIM IF THEY HAVE NEVER **HEARD** ABOUT HIM? AND HOW CAN THEY **HEAR** ABOUT HIM UNLESS SOMEONE TELLS THEM?...**SO FAITH COMES FROM HEARING, THAT IS, HEARING THE GOOD NEWS ABOUT CHRIST.**"

BELIEVE

THE NEXT THING THE NEW TESTAMENT TEACHES ABOUT **FAITHFULNESS** IS **BELIEVING THAT JESUS IS THE MESSIAH.**

ROMANS 10:9-10 SAYS, "IF YOU OPENLY DECLARE THAT JESUS IS LORD AND **BELIEVE IN YOUR HEART THAT GOD RAISED HIM FROM THE DEAD, YOU WILL BE SAVED.** FOR IT IS BY **BELIEVING IN YOUR HEART** THAT YOU ARE MADE RIGHT WITH GOD, AND IT IS BY OPENLY DECLARING YOUR FAITH THAT YOU ARE SAVED."

MESSIAH

THIS WORD MEANS, "SOMEONE WHO IS ANOINTED BY GOD TO BE THE KING!" THE GREEK WORD IS "CHRIST."



JOHN 3:16 SAYS,
"FOR THIS IS HOW GOD
LOVED THE WORLD:
HE GAVE HIS ONE AND
ONLY SON, SO THAT
EVERYONE WHO
BELIEVES IN HIM WILL
NOT PERISH BUT HAVE
ETERNAL LIFE."

DO YOU BELIEVE THAT JESUS IS THE
MESSIAH, SON OF THE LIVING GOD?

JOHN 20:31 SAYS, "BUT THESE
[TRUE STORIES ABOUT JESUS]
ARE WRITTEN SO THAT YOU
MAY CONTINUE TO **BELIEVE**
THAT JESUS IS THE MESSIAH,
THE SON OF GOD, AND THAT
BY **BELIEVING** IN HIM YOU
WILL HAVE LIFE BY THE
POWER OF HIS NAME."

DO YOU BELIEVE THAT
JESUS DIED ON THE
CROSS FOR YOUR SINS?

DO YOU BELIEVE THAT JESUS
WAS RAISED TO LIFE AGAIN?

IF YOU ANSWERED "**YES!**"
TO THESE QUESTIONS
ABOUT JESUS' IDENTITY
AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS,
THEN IT'S TIME TO LOOK AT
THE THIRD THING THE NEW
TESTAMENT TEACHES
ABOUT FAITHFULNESS:
REPENTANCE.

JESUS SAID IN LUKE 13:3,
"...YOU WILL PERISH, TOO,
UNLESS YOU **REPENT OF**
YOUR SINS AND TURN TO GOD."

REPENT

THIS WORD MEANS, "TO CHANGE
ONE'S ALLEGIANCE." WE DECIDE
THAT WE DON'T WANT TO PLAY FOR
THE SELFISH, HATEFUL TEAM THAT
LEADS TO FAILURE. INSTEAD, WE'RE
GOING TO PLAY FOR GOD'S TEAM
THAT WILL ULTIMATELY WIN.



ACTS 3:19-20 SAYS, "NOW **REPENT OF YOUR SINS** AND TURN TO GOD, SO THAT YOUR SINS MAY BE WIPED AWAY. THEN TIMES OF REFRESHMENT WILL COME FROM THE PRESENCE OF THE LORD, AND HE WILL AGAIN SEND YOU JESUS, YOUR APPOINTED MESSIAH."

ACTS 17:30 SAYS, "GOD OVERLOOKED PEOPLE'S IGNORANCE ABOUT THESE THINGS IN EARLIER TIMES, BUT NOW HE COMMANDS EVERYONE EVERYWHERE TO **REPENT OF THEIR SINS** AND TURN TO HIM."

REPENTANCE IS MORE THAN JUST SWITCHING ALLEGIANCES FOR ONE DAY. IT ALSO MEANS THAT WE OUGHT TO KEEP OUR ALLEGIANCE TO JESUS OUR ENTIRE LIVES. JOHN THE BAPTIST SAID IN LUKE 3:8, "PROVE BY THE WAY YOU LIVE THAT YOU HAVE **REPENTED OF YOUR SINS** AND TURNED TO GOD. DON'T JUST SAY TO EACH OTHER, 'WE'RE SAFE...'"

DECLARE

IF YOU'RE A FOLLOWER OF JESUS, YOU CANNOT STAY QUIET ABOUT IT! THROUGHOUT THE NEW TESTAMENT WE READ THAT **DECLARING** THE TRUTH ABOUT JESUS' IDENTITY IS CRUCIAL TO RECEIVING GOD'S GRACE.



1 JOHN 4:15 SAYS, "ALL WHO **DECLARE** THAT JESUS IS THE SON OF GOD HAVE GOD LIVING IN THEM, AND THEY LIVE IN GOD."

ROMANS 10:9-10 SAYS, "IF YOU **OPENLY DECLARE THAT JESUS IS LORD** AND BELIEVE IN YOUR HEART THAT GOD RAISED HIM FROM THE DEAD, YOU WILL BE SAVED. FOR IT IS BY BELIEVING IN YOUR HEART THAT YOU ARE MADE RIGHT WITH GOD, AND IT IS BY **OPENLY DECLARING YOUR FAITH THAT YOU ARE SAVED.**"

1 JOHN 2:23 SAYS, "ANYONE WHO DENIES THE SON DOESN'T HAVE THE FATHER, EITHER. BUT ANYONE WHO **ACKNOWLEDGES THE SON** HAS THE FATHER ALSO."

JESUS SAID IN MATTHEW 10:32-33, "EVERYONE WHO **ACKNOWLEDGES ME PUBLICLY** HERE ON EARTH, I WILL ALSO ACKNOWLEDGE BEFORE MY FATHER IN HEAVEN. BUT EVERYONE WHO DENIES ME HERE ON EARTH, I WILL ALSO DENY BEFORE MY FATHER IN HEAVEN."

DON'T EVER BE ASHAMED TO **DECLARE** THAT YOU ARE A FOLLOWER OF JESUS!

BE BAPTIZED

THE FIFTH THING THAT THE NEW TESTAMENT TEACHES ABOUT BEING SAVED IS CALLED **BAPTISM**.

THIS WORD MEANS, "TO IMMERSE" IN THE ORIGINAL GREEK, IT HAS ALWAYS SIGNIFIED A COMPLETE SUBMERGENCE IN LIQUID.



BAPTISM WAS A BRAND NEW THING WHEN THE EARLIEST FOLLOWERS OF JESUS BEGAN TO PRACTICE IT IN THE FIRST CENTURY. PEOPLE WOULD FINALIZE THEIR COMMITMENT TO JESUS BY HAVING ANOTHER FOLLOWER SUBMERGE THEM COMPLETELY IN WATER. METAPHORICALLY, BAPTISM IS SIMILAR TO A WEDDING.

ACTS 2:38 SAYS, "PETER REPLIED, 'EACH OF YOU MUST REPENT OF YOUR SINS AND TURN TO GOD, AND **BE BAPTIZED IN THE NAME OF JESUS CHRIST** FOR THE FORGIVENESS OF YOUR SINS. THEN YOU WILL RECEIVE THE GIFT OF THE HOLY SPIRIT.'"



THE ANCIENT GREEK WRITER NICANDER USED THE WORD **BAPTIZE** IN HIS RECIPE FOR PICKLES! IN ORDER FOR YOUR CUCUMBERS TO BE TRANSFORMED INTO PICKLES YOU MUST COMPLETELY SUBMERGE THEM (**BAPTIZE**) IN A VINEGAR SOLUTION.



JESUS COMMANDED HIS FOLLOWERS IN MATTHEW 28:19, "THEREFORE, GO AND MAKE DISCIPLES OF ALL THE NATIONS, **BAPTIZING THEM IN THE NAME OF THE FATHER AND THE SON AND THE HOLY SPIRIT.**"

THERE IS SO MUCH TO LEARN AND KNOW ABOUT BAPTISM, SO HERE IS A COMPLETE LIST OF THE VERSIONS OF **BAPTISM** FROM THE NEW TESTAMENT:

EVERY TIME THE NEW TESTAMENT USES THE WORD BAPTIZE, BAPTIST, BAPTIZED, BAPTISM, OR BAPTIZING:

IN THE GOSPELS:

1. JOHN THE BAPTIST BAPTIZES OTHERS - MATTHEW 3:1-12; MARK 1:1-8; LUKE 3:1-20; JOHN 1:19-28

9. JESUS COMMISSIONS HIS FOLLOWERS TO BAPTIZE EVERYONE ON EARTH - MATTHEW 28:16-20; MARK 16:14-20

"BAPTISM" IN THE BOOK OF ACTS:

"BAPTISM" IN THE EPISTLES:

1. BAPTISM MEANS WE ARE BURIED WITH CHRIST AND WE ARE ALSO RESURRECTED WITH HIM. IN BAPTISM WE DIE TO OUR SLAVERY OF SIN, AND WE ARE REBORN TO A "SLAVERY TO RIGHTEOUSNESS" - ROMANS CHAPTER 6
2. PAUL RECOUNTS WHO HE BAPTIZED IN CORINTH, AND SAYS THAT JESUS DIDN'T SEND HIM TO BAPTIZE BUT TO PREACH THE GOOD NEWS - 1 CORINTHIANS 1:13-17



"BAPTISM" IN THE EPISTLES (CONTINUED...):

3. PAUL SAYS THAT THE ISRAELITE PEOPLE WERE BAPTIZED BY THE CLOUD THAT FOLLOWED THEM IN THE WILDERNESS AND THE SEA THAT WAS PARTED FOR THEM TO ESCAPE FROM EGYPT -
1 CORINTHIANS 10:2
4. NO MATTER WHO WE ARE, WE ARE ALL BAPTIZED INTO ONE BODY AND WE SHARE THE SAME HOLY SPIRIT - 1 CORINTHIANS 12:13
5. PAUL ASKS WHY WE SHOULD BAPTIZE PEOPLE IF WE DON'T BELIEVE THEY WILL BE RAISED FROM THE DEAD - 1 CORINTHIANS 15:29
6. ALL WHO HAVE BEEN BAPTIZED, HAVE BEEN CLOTHED WITH CHRIST - GALATIANS 3:27
7. ALL BELIEVERS ARE UNITED UNDER ONE BODY, ONE SPIRIT, ONE LORD, ONE FAITH, ONE BAPTISM, AND ONE GOD - EPHESIANS 4:5
8. BAPTISM IS LIKE A SPIRITUAL CIRCUMCISION, AND IT MEANS THAT WE ARE BURIED WITH CHRIST AND RAISED TO NEW LIFE -
COLOSSIANS 2:11-12
9. THE MATURE CHRISTIAN DOESN'T NEED TO BE RE-TAUGHT THE FUNDAMENTALS OF THE FAITH LIKE BAPTISM - HEBREWS 6:1-2
10. NOAH AND THE OTHERS ON THE ARK WERE SAVED FROM GOD'S WRATH OF A WORLD-WIDE FLOOD. IN THE SAME WAY, BAPTISM NOW SAVES YOU BY GIVING YOU A CLEAN CONSCIENCE AND THE HOPE OF RESURRECTION - 1 PETER 3:19-21



OTHER NEW TESTAMENT PASSAGES THAT ALLUDE TO BAPTISM:

THE FREE BENEFITS OF BECOMING A CHRISTIAN:

1. YOUR SINS ARE FORGIVEN AND YOU ARE NO LONGER CONDEMNED TO DEATH AND HELL - ACTS 2:38; ROMANS 8:1; COLOSSIANS 1:22
2. YOUR SOUL WILL LIVE IN HEAVEN AFTER YOU DIE - ROMANS 6:23
3. YOUR NAME IS WRITTEN IN "THE LAMB'S BOOK OF LIFE" - PHILIPPIANS 4:3; REVELATION 3:5; REVELATION 20:12
4. YOU ARE GOD'S CHILDREN AND CO-HEIRS OF JESUS' GLORY- JOHN 1:12; ROMANS 8:17; GALATIANS 4:7; 1 PETER 1:4
5. YOU ARE NO LONGER A SLAVE TO SIN AND DEATH, NOW A SLAVE TO DOING THE RIGHT THING (RIGHTEOUSNESS) - ROMANS 6
6. THE HOLY SPIRIT COMES INTO YOUR LIFE TO HELP YOU CHOOSE THE RIGHT PATH EVERY DAY - ACTS 2:38; ROMANS 8:5-11
7. YOU RECEIVE A TALENT FROM THE HOLY SPIRIT (THE BIBLE CALLS IT A "SPIRITUAL GIFT") WHICH HELPS YOU SERVE WITHIN A CHURCH - ROMANS CHAPTER 12; 1 CORINTHIANS CHAPTERS 12-14; EPHESIANS CHAPTER 4
8. YOU ARE A PART OF THE FAMILY OF GOD (THE CHURCH), WITH SPIRITUAL BROTHERS, SISTERS, MOTHERS, AND FATHERS WHO LIFT YOU UP WHEN YOU ARE DOWN, AND ENCOURAGE YOU WHEN YOU FAIL - ROMANS 12:9-16
9. YOU WILL PARTICIPATE IN "THE LORD'S SUPPER" WHERE ALL CHRISTIANS EAT BREAD AND DRINK JUICE TO REMEMBER JESUS' SACRIFICE FOR US - MATTHEW 26:26-29; 1 CORINTHIANS 11:23-34
10. ON THE DAY OF RESURRECTION (NO ONE KNOWS WHEN THIS IS) YOU WILL RECEIVE A GLORIFIED BODY WHICH WILL NEVER DIE - 1 CORINTHIANS 15; 2 CORINTHIANS 5:1-10; PHILIPPIANS 3:20-21

REMEMBER, FOLLOWING JESUS IS ALL ABOUT **FATHFULNESS!** THESE FIVE THINGS (HEAR, BELIEVE, REPENT, DECLARE, AND BE BAPTIZED) ARE JUST THE BEGINNING OF A LIFETIME OF OBEDIENCE TO JESUS.
